The aforesaid Appeal was presented at the filing counter on 29.06.2017. The Appeal when scrutinised on 30.06.2017 was found to be defective. Hence, the Section concerned informed the clerk of the appellant's counsel of the defects on 03.07.2017 and they were also directed to cure the defects within a period of seven days.

The defective Appeal was taken back on 05.07.2017 for rectification. The period of seven days expired on 10.07.2017.
