## ORDER

19.04.2018- According to the Appellant, the National Company Law Tribunal on the basis of forged certificates of transfer of shares, came to the conclusion that the Appellants are not the members of the Company and set aside their appointment as Director(s). Learned counsel placed reliance on Forensic Report submitted by the Assistant Director, Government of Andhra Pradesh (at Page No. 875) to suggest that the transfer certificates marked as Q1 to Q4 were not executed with any writing instrument and are forged.

Issue notice. Mr. Y. Rajagopala Rao, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of 1<sup>st</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> Respondents and Mr. K. Anandh, Advocate accepts

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notice on behalf of 29th to 32nd Respondents. No further notice need be

issued to them. They may file replies along with their respective

vakalatnama(s) within 10 days. The Appellants may file rejoinder to the

reply within a week thereof.

Let notice be issued on rest of the Respondents. Requisite along

with process fee, if not filed, be filed by 20th April, 2018. If the Appellants

provide the e-mail address of Respondents, let notice be also issued

through e-mail.

Post the matter before appropriate Bench on 9th May, 2018.

In the meantime, the Respondents will not alienate or transfer any

property of the 1st Appellant Company without prior permission to the

Appellate Tribunal.
