ORDER

25.04.2018: Mr. Uddyam Mukherjee, learned counsel appears on behalf of 2nd Respondent. Service is complete and notice on the 1st Respondent – Commission has already been served. Mr. Dushyant K. Mahant who is appearing in another appeal is allowed to accept notice on behalf of the Commission.

Taking into consideration that the same impugned order has been challenged in Competition Appeal (AT) No. 23 of 2017 etc. and grounds shown for condonation of delay, we condone the delay for 91 days in preferring the appeal. I. A. No. 27 of 2018 stands disposed of.

In the meantime, the impugned order dated 14th September, 2017 so far it relates to imposition of penalty on the Appellants shall remain stayed subject to payment of 10% of the penalty amount by way of FDR in favour of 'Registrar, NCLAT' within 10 days.
