ORDER

18.04.2017 - Let notices be issued on Respondents by Speed Post to state whether the petition for extension of time was maintainable before the National Company Law Tribunal (hereinafter referred to as Tribunal) or not in view of the fact that the High Court only passed order in the ^{1st} Motion in a Company petition under Section 391 to 394 of the Companies Act, 1956 and the said petition may not stand transferred to the Tribunal under Section 434 (c) of the Companies Act, 2013.
