**ORDER**

**31.08.2017** — The Registry has failed to notice that the Appellant has challenged two orders, one dated 24<sup>th</sup> May 2017 and the other dated 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017 but the Appellant has paid only one fee. Therefore, either the Appellant should have been allowed to confine his appeal against one order or should have been asked to pay fee for the other appeal also. Ld. Counsel for the Appellant submits that the Appellant will pay another fee so that both the orders can be considered by the Appellate Tribunal on the basis of common pleading. The Appellant is allowed a week's time to pay another fee. The Registry will also allot another appeal number and treat the Paper Book as complete for both the appeals.
