ORDER

This appeal has been preferred by Mr. Ravindra Gopal, proprietor of AVON Capital against the order dated 11th July, 2017 passed by the Adjudicating Authority (National Company Law Tribunal), Mumbai Bench after delay of 12 days along with the petition of condonation of delay with grounds mentioned therein. The main plea taken by the appellant is that the free copy of the impugned order was provided to the appellant on 28th September, 2017, whereinafter the appeal was filed on 1st November, 2017.

The respondent has opposed the prayer on the ground that no sufficient cause has been shown to condone the delay.

From the record, as we find that free copy of the impugned order was communicated to the appellant on 28th September, 2017 whereinafter steps was

taken to prefer the appeal. The Demand Draft was prepared on $27^{\rm th}$ October,

2017 and then the appeal was filed on 1st November, 2017 and as per sub-section

(2) of Section 61 of the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (hereinafter referred

to as the, 'I&B Code') the appeal was to be filed within 30 days, there is actual

delay of five days in preferring the appeal. We being satisfied with the grounds

shown, the five days delay in preferring the appeal is condoned.

I.A. No. 795 of 2017 stands disposed of.
