**O R D E R**

**28.08.2018** - This joint appeal has been preferred by 32 companies against common order dated 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2018. As each company has separate cause of action and they are individually aggrieved, technically the joint appeal is not maintainable. However, if they deposit separate fee for rest of the 31 companies alongwith respective affidavit of the other 31 companies, the appeal can be treated to be with different appeal having separate appeal number, though appellant can rely on the same paper book.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant prays for and allowed to deposit a week time further 31 sets of court fees. The office will provide 32 separate appeal number(s), including the present Company Appeal (AT)(Insolvency) No.267 of 2018.

3. In the meantime, let notice be issued on respondent. Mr. Ashim Sood, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. No further notice be issued

on respondents. Let short reply be filed within 10 days on the question of grant of interim relief.

4. Place the case for admission on 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 before the 1<sup>st</sup> Court within first two cases.
