O R D E R

29.08.2018: Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellant submits that the Company itself has accepted in its affidavit that the Appellant is the shareholder, which has also been reflected in the records of the Company. It is further submitted that there being three shareholders, the Appellant is eligible in terms of Section 244 being one-tenth of the shareholder, and not “one-third of the shareholding of the Company”.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellant further submits that if the delay is calculated from the date of issuance of free certified copy of the impugned order i.e. order dated 27th April, 2018, it will be 91st day on which the appeal was file. He requested to grant time to find out as to when the free copy of order was served on the Appellant, if sent by post and if so necessary Appellant be allowed to file another petition for condonation of delay showing exact number of days of delay.

Learned counsel for the Appellant prays for and allowed a weeks' time to file another petition.
