05.02.2018 It appears that the case of “Nikhil Mehta Vs. AMR Infrastructure Ltd.” in C.P. No. (ISB)-03(PB)/2017 is still pending before the learned Adjudicating Authority (National Company Law Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi) though the matter was remanded on 21.07.2017. For the aforesaid reason, the Appellant is not in a position to pursue his case in view of the order of this Appellate Tribunal dated 21.07.2017. As more than six months has passed after remand of the matter to the learned Adjudicating Authority, we hope and trust that the learned Adjudicating Authority will deliberate on the issue in the case of “Nikhil Mehta & Sons”. If no order is passed either by admitting or dismissing the aforesaid case by 09.03.2018, it will be open to the Appellant- Sajive Kanwar to renew the prayers as made in

the I.A.(s) nos. 152-153/2018. We also give liberty the Appellant to bring this order to the notice of the learned Adjudicating Authority. I.A.(s) Nos. 152-153/2018 stand disposed of.
