ORDER

21.02.2018 By way of last chance, we allow the Resolution Applicant to file affidavit and state whether they intend to modify the resolution plan by cutting short the time period of payment of dues. On failure, this Appellate Tribunal may decide the questions as to (i) whether the Resolution Applicant is eligible to file the resolution plan and (ii) whether a long time period can be granted to the Resolution Applicant for payment of the dues of creditors.

In the meantime, it will be also open to the Financial Creditors to file Interlocutory Application(s) for impleadment, if they have any objection to the resolution plan.
