December, 2017. Prayer has been made to allow further four weeks' time

to pay the amount, in view of the fact only sum of Rs. 7 lakhs is available

in the account whereas Rs. 5 lakhs is payable for the month of

December.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellant submits

that the period of moratorium will come to an end by the end of January,

2018 and if the amount is not paid, it is open to the Appellant to

disconnect the electricity after the period of moratorium is over.

the month of December, 2017 by 7th February, 2018, failing which, it
