## <u>O R D E R</u>

**23.01.2018-** From paragraph 12 of the impugned order, we find that the Adjudicating Authority (National Company Law Tribunal), Mumbai Bench rejected the application preferred by the appellant under Section 7 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the "I & B Code") for the reasons mentioned therein.
