25.01.2018- The question arises for consideration in this appeal is whether Section 10 of the CPC will be applicable in a petition under Sections 397 & 398 of the Companies Act, 1956 (now Section 241 of the Companies Act, 2013) and such case can await disposal of an execution case, if there is allegation of 'oppression and mismanagement' as was prayed for by the Appellant.
