ORDER

30.01.2018. This appeal has been preferred by the Appellant M/s Eastern Plastix against order dated 31st August, 2017 passed by Adjudicating Authority (National Company Law Tribunal) Chennai Bench in CP No. CP/474/(IB)/CB/2017 along with the petition for condonation of delay.

The appeal has been preferred after delay. From the records we find that the copy of the impugned order dated 31st August, 2017 was served upon the appellant on 6th September, 2017 and appeal was preferred by appellant and presented on 10th October, 2017. In fact the defects have been removed and it was represented on 12th January, 2018. In view of the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court, the date of presenting the case will be taken as date of filing. Therefore, we hold that the appeal has been preferred after delay of 4 days and not 98 days.

Having heard Learned Counsel for the Appellant and on being satisfied with the grounds shown, we condone the delay. I.A. No.25 of 2018 stands disposed of.
