ORDER

05.07.2018— The question arises for consideration in this appeal is whether the transaction entered between the 'Promoters' and 'Directors' of the 'Corporate Debtor' with Appellant- 'Bank of Maharashtra', which is the 'Financial Creditor' of the parent company of the 'Corporate Debtor' can be held to be fraudulent for the purpose of passing order under Sections 43 & 45 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016.

- 2. Issue notice. Ms. Honey Satpal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the 'Resolution Professional'. No further notice need be issued. She may file reply along with vakalatnama within ten days. Rejoinder, if any, be filed by the Appellant within seven days thereof.
- 3. Learned counsel for the Appellant will file certified copy of the impugned order within ten days.
