## <u>O R D E R</u>

At this stage, we may record the submissions by the learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of Respondent no. 1 and 2 (Petitioner before the Tribunal) that the Tribunal has not stayed the award. He submits that award was stayed by Hon'ble High Court. Learned Counsel prays for and allowed 10 days' time to file reply enclosing the copy of the order, if any, passed by the Hon'ble High Court staying the award.

Pendency of the case will not come in the way of the Tribunal to proceed with the Company Petition on merit which may be taken up without granting unnecessary adjournment to the parties.

Post the matter on 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 before this bench.
