**ORDER**

**27.03.2018-** An application seeking impleadment of Government of Arunachal Pradesh as party in the appeal has been preferred by the Appellant on the ground that the Government of Arunachal Pradesh is 26% equity stakeholders, which may agree to provide appropriate plan to back the company on its own track.

Taking into consideration the nature of prayer, we allow the application and implead the Government of Arunachal Pradesh through Chief Secretary.
