**ORDER**

30.05.2017- Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant submits that when the appellant/petitioner filed Company Petition No.128/2007 before the Company Law Board, Principal Bench, New Delhi he had 19.2% shareholding with the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent company. During the pendency of the Company Petition, the Company Law Board passed an interim order on 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2007 directing the parties to maintain status quo with regard to shareholding and fixed assets. In spite of the same during the pendency of the Company Petition the respondent transferred the company in favour of the third party and the shareholding of the appellant herein reduced to 1.12% in violation of the interim order of status quo with a view to oppress the appellant and mis-manage the company.

Let notice be issued on respondents. Shri H. Barua, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of 1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> Respondent. No further notice be issued on them. Let notice be issued on rest of the respondents by speed post. Requisites alongwith process, if not filed, be filed by tomorrow. If the appellant provides

the e-mail address of rest of the respondent, let notice be also issued on them through e-mail.

Post the matter on 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2017.

In the meantime, Respondent may file reply affidavit and the appellant may file rejoinder.

In the meantime, parties may maintain status quo in so far as shareholding and fixed assets of 1<sup>st</sup> respondent company. However, the order of Status quo will not come in the way of 1<sup>st</sup> respondent company to obtain loan in accordance with law.
