01.05.2018 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of appellant referring to the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta in C.P. No. 461 of 2009 (at pages 283 and 295) submitted that winding up application under Section 433(e) of the Companies Act, 1956 stands admitted in view of the order of the advertisement ordered by the High Court. Therefore, according to him, the application under Section 10 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 preferred by the respondent – 'Corporate Debtor' was not maintainable. In this regard, a reference has been made to the decision of this Appellate Tribunal in "M/s. Unigreen Global Private Limited vs. Punjab National Bank and others" – Company Appeal (AT) (Insolvency) 81/2017.
