filed within five days thereof.

Let notice be issued on the rest of the Respondents by speed post.

Requisite along with process fee, if not filed, be filed by 4th May, 2018. If

the Appellant provides the e-mail address of the Respondents, let notice

be also issued through e-mail.

Post the matter on 23rd May, 2018.

During the pendency of the appeal, the Board of Directors will co-

operate with the 'Resolution Professional' and provide documents which

relates to the 'Corporate Debtor'. The 'Resolution Professional' will not

ask for any document not related to the company in question.
