<u>O R D E R</u>

21.05.2018- Learned counsel submits that the 'steel plates of 100 mm and steel rods' of which details have been shown at Page Nos. 75 to 83 belong to the Appellant- a third party, which were entrusted to the 'Corporate Debtor' for manufacturing of boilers and to supply them to the Appellant. According to him, the materials entrusted by him for manufacturing of boilers are not covered by 'Moratorium' and the 'Resolution Professional' cannot take possession of the same and should release the same.

Let notice be issued on Respondent by speed post. Requisite along with process fee, if not filed, be filed by 22nd May, 2018. If the Appellant provides the e-mail address of the Respondent, let notice be also issued through e-mail. Post the matter on 5th July, 2018.
