## <u>ORDER</u>

**30.05.2018** Learned counsel for the appellant submits that without serving any notice under Section 8(1) of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (in Form 3 or in Form 4) an application under Section 9 was filed by the respondent ('Operational Creditor').
