ORDER

14.09.2017 It is informed that the Adjudicating Authority (National Company Law Tribunal), Division Bench, Chennai has not forwarded free certified copy of the impugned order dated 30th May, 2017 passed in CP/472(IB)/CB/2017 (IND/822/(IB)/CB/2017. The appellant could come to know of the same on 16th June, 2017 and preferred the appeal on 28th July, 2017. Under sub-section (2) of Section 61 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as T&B Code'), the appeal is required to be filed within 30 days. As the date of knowledge of the impugned order to the appellant is 16th June, 2017, the period of 30 days completes on 16th July, 2017. Thus, we find that there is a delay of 12 days in

preferring the appeal which the counsel for the appellant has taken

to prepare the appeal.

Having heard the learned counsel for the appellant and the

learned counsel for the respondent and being satisfied with the

grounds for delay, the delay of 12 days in preferring the appeal is

condoned.

Accordingly, I.A. No. 423 of 2017 stands disposed of.
