<u>O R D E R</u>

15.05.2018 We have heard the counsel for some time in these matters to understand what is the dispute. We have seen the Impugned Order and the rectification application (Volume V page – 886) which is pending before NCLT. This Tribunal has already directed on 24th January, 2018 the NCLT that

pendency of these appeals will not come in the way of the Tribunal to rectify the mistake if there is an error in the Impugned Order. We are told that the rectification application was taken up for arguments and arguments remained part heard. We are told that the rectification application is listed on 8th June, 2018 for further arguments.
